ISSHP CONGRESS AWARDS

1. INVESTIGATOR AWARDS

ISSHP will sponsor sixteen €500 investigator awards. This is issued by ISSHP as a nonreturnable educational grant presented to each awardee at the opening ceremony of the meeting. The conference organisers are asked to reserve 15 minutes at the opening ceremony to allow these awards to be presented.

The conference organisers are asked to include a check box on the abstract submission form for young investigators to self-identify.

Criteria for a young Investigator are:

- a) A primary contribution to research in the past four years; and
- b) In full-time postdoctoral training, residency, or fellowship, or enrolment in a formally approved training program leading to a degree (BA, BS, MD, PhD, MS, MPH, DVM).
- c) These will be announced prior to the meeting.

Four presentation prizes will be paid for by ISSHP and allocated to:

Best oral presentation and poster presentation in Clinical sciences €500 each

Best oral presentation and poster presentation Basic sciences €500 each

These will be awarded at the end of the meeting. All awards will be paid directly to recipients by ISSHP.

2. MOODLEY AWARD

The Moodley award is given to a member of the Society in recognition of her/his sustained and substantial contribution to research in preeclampsia and is awarded at every second ISSHP meeting. The recipient will work and predominantly conduct their research in a Low to Middle Income Country (LMIC). This award will be given in 2023. This is a nonreturnable prize of €1000. This prize will be transferred directly to the recipient. Conference organisers are asked to reserve a 15-minute oral presentation slot at the opening ceremony for this presentation. This will be sponsored by Elsevier in 2023.

All awards will be paid directly to recipients by ISSHP.

This award alternates with the Chesley Award which will be given in 2024. The Chesley Award is not LMIC limited.
